The Certificate III in Non-Emergency Patient Transport is one of the easiest entry points into the health care industry.

Upon completion of this course, graduates will have developed essential skills for assessing, transporting and caring for patients who are classed as non-acute or don't suffer from chronic illness.

The Certificate III in Non-Emergency Patient Transport course is delivered online, allowing for complete freedom and flexibility to learn when it suits you the best.

There is a 3 day clinical workshop to attend, where the focus is on gaining essential clinical and hands-on skills using specialised equipment. There is an ambulance driving component, where time spent behind the wheel gives you the confidence required to operate a larger vehicle on busy roads. Choose from various training locations across Australia: Burleigh Heads, 4220 QLD, Smeaton Grange, 2567 NSW, Carrum Downs, 3201 VIC, Welshpool, 6106 WA.

There are 13 units of competency to complete in this course, which on average takes 6-12 months to complete.

- Parent consent if under 18 years of age
- Computer literacy
- Australian resident/citizen or approved temporary visa
- Medical consent if a medical condition is applicable
