Choosing to study paramedical concepts online means you decide how quickly you work through the course. You set aside the hours you feel will be beneficial to your learning.


Adult learning is very different from when you were at school. This time, you have complete control over the learning process because everyone is different, one-size-fits-all education is a thing of the past.

- [HLT31115 – Certificate III Non-Emergency Patient Transport](#) (Patient Transport Officer, Ambulance Assistant, Ambulance Call Taker)
- [HLT41115 – Certificate IV Health Care](#) (Ambulance Dispatcher, Ambulance Support Officer, Basic Life Support Medic)
- [HLT51015– Diploma of Paramedical Science](#) (Ambulance Paramedic Assistant, Advanced Life Support Medic)

Qualification Overviews



HLT31115 - Certificate III in Non-Emergency Patient Transport

For those who are more comfortable beginning with the basic qualifications, the patient transport sector is a good place to start.

The [HLT31115 – Certificate III Non-Emergency Patient Transport](#) qualification is required for a career in the industry. Completion time 6-12 months.

Jobs for Certificate III graduates;

- Non-Emergency Patient Transport Officer. Provide transportation and care of low-risk patients who are classed as non-acute or suffer from a disability
- Ambulance Assistant
- Ambulance Call Taker
- Ambulance community or volunteer officer
- Private hospital orderly & Patient Transport Officer
- Nursing homes; non-emergency client transport driver



HLT41115 - Certificate IV in Health Care (Basic Life Support)

The next level up is the [HLT41115 - Certificate IV in Health Care](#) which covers pre-hospital emergency health care at the basic life support level. This course is to be completed within 18 months.

Jobs for Certificate IV graduates; *some of these jobs need further qualifications

- Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)
- Ambulance Dispatcher (000 call centre operations)
- Ambulance Support Officer
respond quickly to emergency situations regarding medical issues, traumatic injuries and accident scenes; they provide basic life support to patients
- First Responder in the transport, aviation or maritime medic sectors
- Industrial medic (mining, construction, manufacturing, oil & gas)
Immense opportunities to work in diverse and interesting job roles
- Private company medic (Australia and international)
Work with individual organisations providing medical services to support a workforce



HLT51015 – Diploma of Paramedical Science

The top level course is the [HLT51015 – Diploma of Paramedical Science](#) which qualifies graduates to respond to emergency situations and be responsible for patient management. Graduates of the Diploma are classed as Advanced Life Support Medics and/or Paramedic Assistants.

Diploma-qualified medics are authorised to administer a wide range of techniques, including; intra osseous cannula insertion, advanced drug and fluid administration, cardiac arrest and Electrocardiogram (ECG) monitoring and interpretation.

Jobs for Diploma graduates;

- Ambulance Paramedic Assistant
Medic in the private sector (construction, manufacturing, hospitality)
- Industrial Medic - oil & gas, offshore paramedic, remote mine sites
- Emergency Response Officer at airports, transport companies, sea-going vessels, merchant navy etc
- Emergency Services Medic, State Emergency Services, volunteer rescue, search and rescue
- Event Medic/First Responder
- Diploma graduates apply to study a Bachelor of Paramedic Science at university; apply to work with the London Ambulance Service as a UK registered Paramedic



Complete Your Training Sooner

Gaining pre-hospital emergency health care qualifications in your spare time is one of the best ways to complete the training.

The fact that you can choose the number of hours you wish to study, gives you the option to graduate sooner. Of course, this does not mean you can take forever, because there are time frames within which you must complete your training.
