HLT41120 – CERTIFICATE IV IN HEALTH CARE

The HLT41120 – Certificate IV in Health Care is an entry-level qualification offering pathways to careers in the prehospital emergency health care sector (private sector).

At this level, graduates possess the required skills for primary and secondary patient assessment; use clinical reasoning to conduct patient assessment and apply immediate treatment.

Graduates are able to confidently prepare patients to receive advanced medical care where required.

The HLT41120 – Certificate IV in Health Care course is a blended delivery model, allowing students to fit study around their current lifestyle.

There are 16 units of competency in this qualification. The theory is completed online via an easy-to-use learning platform. Course completion time frames can vary between 12-18 months.

Attendance at a 7 day Clinical Intensive Workshop and 80 hours of supervised Clinical Placement are also required. Clinical workshops are held at training campuses on the Gold Coast (Burleigh), New South Wales, Victoria and Western Australia (Perth).



ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Minimum 16 years of age
- Language, literacy and numeracy competency for those under 17 years and as requested
- Parental consent if under 18 years of age
- Computer literacy
- Australian resident, Australian citizen or approved temporary visa
- Medical declaration if a medical condition is applicable
